TOURNAMENT RULES (Contact WCUSBCA Office with any question 914-332-7113)

1. All entrants must be current members of the Westchester County United States Bowling Congress Association or a resident of Westchester County. All others are excluded.
2. All entrants must be at least 50 years of age.
3. This handicap tournament will consist of three (3) games.
4. Multiple participation will be permitted with the following limitations: A bowler may appear only once on the prize list for position standings. Availability- As priority will be given to bowlers who did not participate on the first Scheduled date
5. Entrants must use their highest USBC average bowled in a certified winter league for the 2025-2026 season with a minimum of 21 games. Entrants without a 2025-2026 winter average will use 2026 summer league certified average with a minimum of 21 games. If neither, will use the 2024-2025 winter average. Entrants without either of these will use their current 2026-27 certified average, provided they have bowled a minimum of 21 games by October 31, 2026. Any bowler with only a challenge or sport condition average will use a converted average. Entrants with none of these averages will bowl scratch. USBC Rule 319-a2 (10 pins or higher than prior year) and USBC Rules 319-d and 319-e, do not apply. Averages will be checked and corrected if in error (USBC Rule 319-a3 is waived).
6. **Handicap will be based on 80% of the difference between the entrant's average and 230 scratch figure.**
7. A bowler who arrives late may bowl starting with the frame being bowled, receiving a zero (0) for the missed frames.
8. If a bowler is unable to finish, no substitutes are allowed.
Replacements will be permitted subject to the approval of the tournament director.
Any entrant not checked-in 10 minutes prior to squad time is subject to replacement.
9. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by the use of abrasives or polish is prohibited during competition. In addition, no substance may be placed on the outer surface of the bowling ball. Bowlers are permitted to sand the surface of their bowling balls prior to certified competition. The use of abrasives strictly is prohibited once bowling begins.
10. Error in scoring or calculation of the handicap must be reported to the tournament director within twenty-four (24) hours after completion of bowling.
11. Any protest must comply with USBC Rule 329.
12. Handicap bowlers requiring aid, such as crutches, canes, wheelchairs, etc., or who are blind, must report this in writing when entry is submitted, so that special consideration can be arranged.
13. In the event of a tie for the Championship, duplicate awards will be given, and co-champions declared. Prize money for ties will be combined and divided equally.
14. Personal checks, postal money orders, bank checks, or bank money orders will be accepted.

16. Walk-ins will be accepted, space permitting, CASH ONLY. There is a **\$10 Walk-in fee**, added to prize fund. Lane accommodations for walk-on will not be honored.
